
What are the Benefits of Able SC's Ticket to Work Program?

What is the Ticket to Work Program?

The Ticket to Work program is designed to help reduce dependency on Social Security and SSI cash benefits. Work Incentives can allow you to keep your benefits while you explore employment, receive vocational support, and gain work experience.

- Ticket to work is a FREE and voluntary program.
- The program is for Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) beneficiaries ages 18 through 64.
- Participants in the Ticket to Work program should have a long-term goal to end reliance on social security benefits (SSI/SSDI)
- Safety nets are available so you can keep your Medicare or Medicaid and in some cases your cash benefits
- Participants receive individualized employment services

Ticket to Work program & Employment Services

Able SC's employment services include:

- Self-esteem/confidence building to prepare for employment
- Access to benefits counseling
- Career options counseling
- Job search skills (resumes, interviews)
- Workplace skill-building (communicating effectively, workplace etiquette, professional relationships, etc.)
- Job performance support
- Troubleshooting Workplace Issues (including disclosure, accommodations, and advocacy)
- Peer Support

If you do not qualify for the Ticket to Work program, you may still be eligible for Able SC Employment Services.
